



**★** Turn on/off Sound

The National Headquarters News (HQN) is best viewed on a larger screen—a computer monitor or laptop—as this helps it look similar to the old paper version. Clicking to the right or left has a simulated animation that looks like you're flipping a physical page—it even includes a page-flipping sound effect (if your sound is on).

If you view the *HQN* on a phone or tablet, check out the toolbar below the displayed pages that helps you adjust your viewing experience (see screenshot to the left). Below, you see a key explaining these symbols, including the menu that pops up when you click the three dots on the right of the toolbar.



- ## ← This toggles thumbnails on & off—mini versions of each page on the left you click to jump to that page
- ⊕ This zooms in on the page (helps with small text)
- ← This zooms back out
- ► This blows the *HQN* up to full-screen size—it can increase the size significantly
- ← This helps you share the HQN with someone else
- ← This lets you search for text found in the HQN

➡ ← This opens up your default print dialog to print the HQN from your computer or mobile device

**Clicking these dots opens up several additional options, the most important being "Download PDF File."** Downloading the PDF allows to open the *HQN* in the PDF-reading program of your choice (often Adobe Reader, but it would open in whatever PDF-viewing program you have on your computer or mobile device).

The *HQN* going digital also allows us to increase some of the smaller font sizes, since increasing the page count no longer lead to significant cost increases.
